

Maan Gram Panchayat is situated in Mulshi Block in Pune district of Maharashtra State. The GP is headed by a Lady Sarpanch. Some of the salient features of this GP are enlisted below:

1. Maan GP is an **ISO 9001:2008 certified Gram Panchayat**. This certificate pertains to the quality management system. The entire official records have been computerized.
2. The Maan GP office houses a **Gram Seva Kendra**, set up to provide various e-services to the citizens of the GP. Some of the services provided by the Gram Seva Kendra are:
  - a. Birth Registration & Certificate.
  - b. Death Registration & Certificate.
  - c. Marriage Registration & Certificate.
  - d. Unemployment Certificate.
  - e. Payment of Electricity Bills.
  - f. Payment of Insurance instalment.
  - g. All types of travel booking, hotel booking.
  - h. Banking Activities.
  - i. All types of recharges (e.g. mobile, DTH etc)
  - j. Payment of all post-paid bills.
  - k. Courier Services
  - l. Agricultural e-Services
3. Maan GP has provided the **facility to pay property tax online** using any national/international credit/debit card. For this purpose, the Maan GP has themselves developed an e-application. More than 50% tax bills and receipts are sent by email to the customers. These online payments are done through Axis Bank.
4. The whole GP office has **Wi-Fi internet connectivity** and staffs are provided with either desktops or laptops for day to day activities. The GP also has a projector for Gram Sabhas, meetings etc. The GP also has a facility for **Video Conferencing**. The attendance of the GP employees is maintained on biometric systems.
5. The GP office runs on **Solar Power**. The Maan GP also plans to provide solar energy to entire village. Maan GP also practices Solid Waste Management, Drainage Water Management, etc.
6. Maan GP has been a recipient of various awards viz Panchayat Shashastikaran Puraskar 2012-13, Yashwant Panchayat Raj Divisional Level Award 2012-13, Gram Swachata Abhiyan, ZP level award 2012-13.
7. Maan GP has also set up a **Community's Information and Training Centre (CIT)** whereby the local unemployed peoples are provided basic IT trainings.
8. **Water Supply Scheme:** Water supply is made available to the employee by the mobile device to stop running water.
9. **Self Help Group (SHG):** There are 50 SHGs existing in Maan GP. Six of these are Below Poverty Line and three out of these three have received loans from bank.
10. **Save Girl Child:** Under this scheme, Maan GP awards Rs. 10,000/- to the parents of girl child.
